SPARKLY STARTER

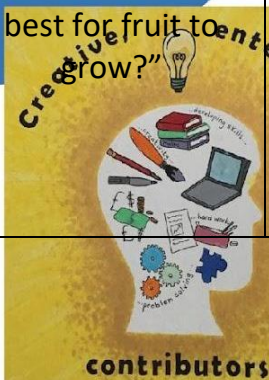

As Linguists we will continue to develop our speaking and listening skills through stories and songs.

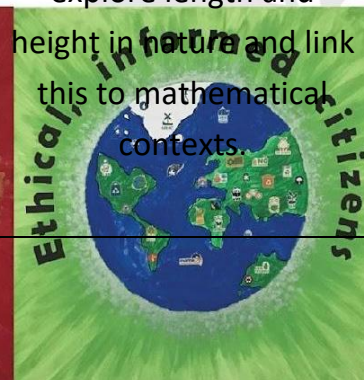

MATHEMATICS & NUMERACY

As Mathematicians we will further develop our knowledge on telling the time including using practical tasks. The children will develop a deeper understanding of fractions.

The children will be using the outdoors to explore length and height in nature and link this to mathematical contexts.

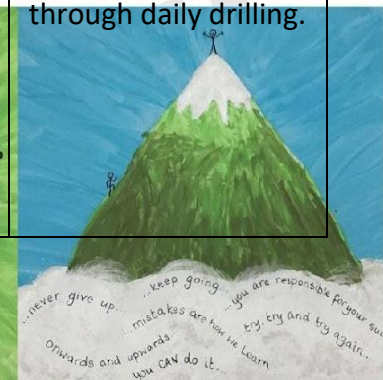


RVE

As part of our RVE curriculum we will be studying. What Paganism is and the beliefs and values of Paganism. The children will have opportunities to explore this in depth.

We will continue to improve our Welsh language skills through daily drilling.



HEALTH & WELLBEING & RSE

Thinking about our wellbeing we will be learning and focusing on the topic of 'Relationships'. We will be sharing our ideas of positive relationships with our peers and how this looks. We will also continue to learn about mindfulness including mindful breathing and listening and how we can use these techniques every day. We will learn about health and wellbeing in our local community and think about the wider world.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

As Scientists we will be developing our investigative skills, using a range of prior and learnt knowledge to make predictions, record results and explain how and why things happen, linking to our topic.

Through technology we will develop our understanding of different apps and build our digital skills. We will also be learning about what it means to be safe when online and the things that we can do to continue to be safe.

We will look at different scenarios and talk about making safe choices.

HUMANITIES

We will be exploring food and farming in depth this term.

We will be looking at food and rationing linking to VE day. We will also be looking at climate change and the reasons behind why not all fruit and vegetables are grown in Wales. Where do the supermarkets get all the fruit and vegetables from? Why can't it be grown in Wales? When did we first start importing food?

We will also be looking at countries around the world where Fruit and vegetables have come from reasons on why they grow there.

We will also be looking our own Cynefin and the farming in our local area.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS

As Artists we will continue to explore and experiment using a variety of techniques and materials. We will explore 3D sculptures and clay.

This will include exploring Arts from our Cynefin and local artists. We will also be completing our film project based on the story of the giant of Glynfach Goch.

During this project we will be writing scripts, designing costumes and acting out the play.

We will listen and learn dances through our Real PE scheme and the children will then perform these to other classes. Musically, we will compose our very own pieces and explore the structure of songs in many ways.
