inhabited

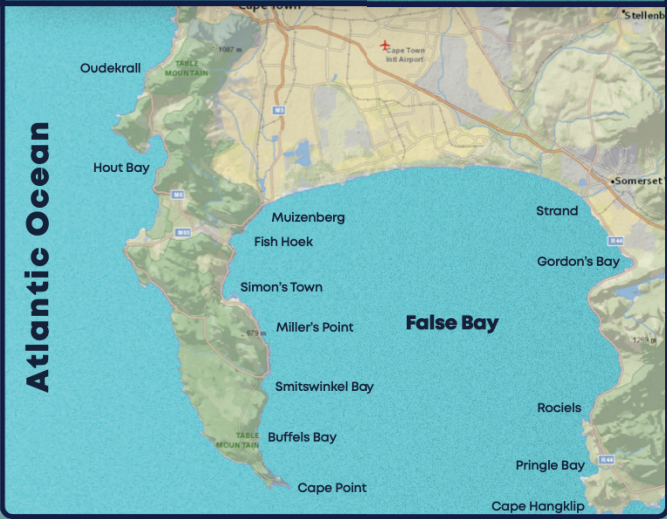
a place that has **people living in it**
