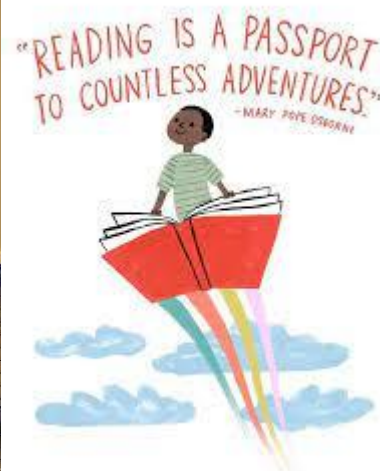

A Few Reminders.....

Water Bottles – All children are encouraged to bring water to school in a clearly labelled bottle and they are able to drink this throughout the day.

Snack – All children are encouraged to bring a healthy snack to school. This could include fruit, crackers, rice cakes or a plain biscuit.
