- Emergency Weather Procedures: As always, this time of year, it is useful to share our bad weather procedures with you. If we have to make the difficult decision of closing the school due to bad weather, then this will be communicated to you through ParentMail, on our school Facebook page and you can also find a list of schools that are closed on the PCC website; https://www.pembrokeshire.gov.uk/school-closures
 As always, we do consider very carefully if we have to close the school and consult with the Chair of Governors before this decision is made. We aim to make a decision as soon as practicably possible.
- Parking: There have been some complaints regarding parking, along the lane at the back of John Street. This is a private lane and should not be used for parking at the start/end of the school day. This has blocked in residents and caused some upset. It is really important that we consider the children and ensure the school site is safe from cars and also conflict between people. Please park respectfully in the appropriate places at all times. Don't forget, we have the Walking Bus in place so please use this rather than driving if you can. The High Street bus is currently not in place, so if anyone else has any thoughts on a new route we could put in place, please let us know.
- Please can I also remind you that the area outside the school with the bollards is left clear for the taxi's that arrive
 with our LRC pupils. It is important that they can safely get to the main entrance safely and this is the best place for
 them to be met by staff and walked in. Thank you.
