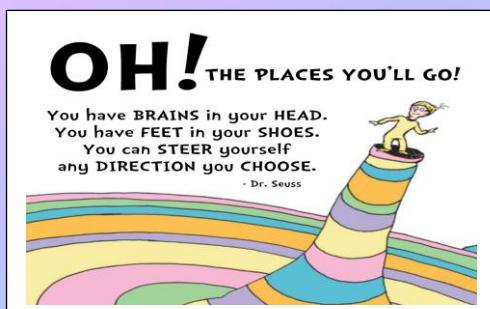
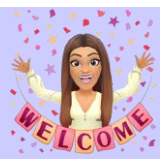






Dosbarth Marloes
