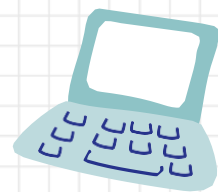




WELCOME TO DOSBARTH WHITESANDS

Reading

Please read with your child as often as possible – even 10 minutes or one page makes a difference. Please record reading on the Boom Reader app. Contact me if you have any problems logging in. Children can also recap their learning using Mathletics, TT Rockstars and Spellzone. Please ask if you need login details. Please bring reading books to school every day.

Uniform

Uniform: Children should wear school uniform Monday–Friday. PE kit should only be worn on PE days (Wednesday and Thursday) and includes a blue/yellow top, black shorts/joggers/leggings, trainers and school hoodie. No crocs. School uniform: blue/yellow polo, black/grey trousers or skirt and royal blue jumper/cardigan/fleece.

Reminders

The school day ends at 3pm – children to be collected from the classroom door or given permission to walk home independently.

Healthy snack: Fruit, vegetable sticks, crackers or a plain biscuit. Water bottle: All children should bring one each day.

Please label everything: Clothing, lunch boxes, snack pots and water bottles.
