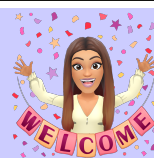
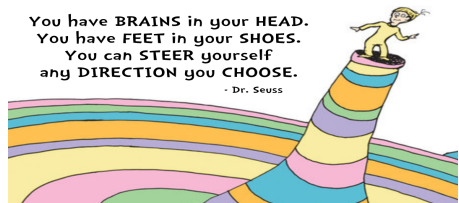

We are encouraging the children to read every day at home. Please can children bring their reading folder to school every day so that we can help them change their books. 'Go Read' log in details have been sent home so you can log reading at home. It will also be used to log any reading done in school.



Uniform - a reminder that all children should be in their school uniform Monday - Friday. PE uniform to be worn on Mondays and Fridays. School hoodie to be worn on PE days only. School uniform - blue/yellow polo top, black jogging trousers or grey trousers, grey skirts, royal blue jumpers/cardigan/fleece. All children need to bring a coat to school, the weather is unpredictable, and we do a lot of learning outdoors too.



PLEASE could all items of clothing, lunch boxes and water bottles have your child's name written on them clearly. These items cost a lot of money and often children have the same things and it becomes difficult to find the rightful owner. Please check that names are attached before bringing them to school - thank you.

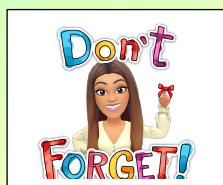
